

Directions for Matching your Existing CITI Account to Your GT Single Sign On Account

If you already have a CITI account, matching the account to your Georgia Tech credentials will help ensure that your CITI course completions are properly logged in Georgia Tech's systems. If you have only accessed CITI through Georgia Tech's Single Sign On (SSO) link, you are probably already matched. However, if you have accessed the CITI Program site without using the SSO feature, if you have a CITI account through another institution, or if you have multiple CITI accounts, your account(s) may not be properly matched. Follow the matching instructions below:

- 1) From the [CITI Online Training for Georgia Tech](#) page, select one of the three training options:

For those who are required to complete online training provided by the CITI Program, please use the links below instead of going directly to the CITI Program's homepage. This will help ensure that any CITI training completions are properly connected to Georgia Tech record systems and that you have an opportunity to review the specific instructions for each type of online course that you plan to complete.



- 2) On the screen that follows click the green "Begin CITI Training" or "Begin CITI RCR Training" button (**IMPORTANT: For security reasons, before clicking the green "button", be sure to close all browser windows and tabs and then reopen your browser. Otherwise you may not get proper credit for your CITI courses.**)



- 3) You will be taken to the CAS Login Screen where you will enter your GT Account and Password (if you don't see this screen, follow the instructions in red above):



- 4) If CITI is able to automatically match your existing CITI account to your Georgia Tech credentials, you will be brought immediately to your CITI main screen – you will see your name in the upper right hand corner (the screen shown below is for example only – what you see may not appear exactly like this).

- 5) If CITI is NOT able to automatically match your SSO account with your existing account, you will see the following screen instead. Click "Continue".



- 6) Select the option to indicate "I already have a CITI Program account."



- 7) You will then be asked to link your existing CITI Program account to your GT SSO account by logging in to your CITI account with the CITI Username and Password that you used when you created your existing CITI account. (If you have forgotten your CITI account username or password, select that option to retrieve your username and/or password):
